INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER

The Liquor Control Board ("LCB") held proceedings in South Burlington, Vermont on June 12, 2013 to consider the The Fitzpatrick Group, LLC's ("Applicant") application for a *Second Class License*. Applicant was present and appeared through Justin C. Fitzpatrick, its sole member, who offered testimony. The Department of Liquor Control ("DLC") was present and represented by Jacob A. Humbert, Esq., Assistant Attorney General.


The LCB has considered and is appreciative of Mr. Fitzpatrick's testimony. By majority vote, however, the LCB requires additional information before it can make a final decision, specifically: letters of reference attesting to Mr. Fitzpatrick's character and fitness to hold a *Second Class License* and a statement from an authorized officer of Brattleboro Probation and Parole concerning Mr. Fitzpatrick's compliance with all probation requirements and the anticipated date that Mr. Fitzpatrick will be discharged from probation.

Accordingly, the LCB hereby *Orders* that within thirty (30) days from date of this *Order*, Applicant shall submit:

- Four (4) letters of reference from individuals, other than members of Mr. Fitzpatrick's family by blood or marriage, regarding Mr. Fitzpatrick's character and fitness to hold a *Second Class License*; and
- A written statement from an authorized officer of Brattleboro Probation and Parole regarding Mr. Fitzpatrick's compliance with all probation requirements and his anticipated date of discharge from probation.
