ORDER GRANTING FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD CLASS LIQUOR LICENSE

The Liquor Control Board (Board) held proceedings on January 15, 2014 in Montpelier to consider KLR Enterprise, Inc. d/b/a Jeff's Maine Seafood's First, Second and Third Class Liquor License Application (Application). Jacob A. Humbert, Esq., Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Department of Liquor Control (DLC). Keith L. Roy, owner and his counsel, Richard R. Goldsborough, Esq., appeared on behalf of the Applicant.

The Board decided, unanimously, to grant the Application subject to the condition that Mr. Roy must comply with and complete all terms and conditions of probation imposed upon him by the Vermont Superior Court Criminal Division, Vermont law enforcement personnel and/or Burlington Probation and Parole. Any violations must be brought to the DLC's attention immediately and a hearing held before the Board to determine the appropriate sanction, if any.
