ORDER GRANTING FIRST CLASS LIQUOR LICENSE

The Liquor Control Board (Board) held proceedings on January 15, 2014 in Montpelier to consider Panda West, LLC's (Applicant) First Class Liquor License Application (the "Application"). Jacob A. Humbert, Esq., Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Vermont Department of Liquor Control (DLC). Jian Guang Wang, Owner, and Mark Raymond, General Manager, appeared on behalf of the Applicant.

Upon consideration of the testimony and evidence presented, the Board decided unanimously to grant the Application subject to the conditions that (1) Mark Raymond remain as General Manager and full-time employee supervising the ordering, sale and service of alcoholic beverages; (2) Mr. Raymond and/or Mr. Wang notify the DLC immediately should Mr. Raymond no longer be so employed; (3) all employees must complete an in-person training seminar through the Department within a reasonable time at any Vermont location where such training is offered; (4) a DLC inspection of the premises is completed and is satisfactory to it; and (5) DLC confirms Applicant's compliance with all business registration requirements set forth by the Vermont Secretary of State.

Should the Applicant/Licensee apply for a Third Class Liquor License and all prerequisites are met per the investigation of the DLC, the Board would grant the license application subject to the same conditions described above.
