SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Elks BPOE Burlington Lodge #916 ("Licensee") was served a Notice of Hearing directing it to appear before the Liquor Control Board ("Board") on July 9, 2014 at Montpelier, Vermont for a contested case hearing to consider the suspension or revocation of its First and Third Class Liquor Licenses and has reached an agreement with the Department of Liquor Control ("DLC") to settle the violation(s) alleged against it in the Notice of Hearing, specifically: General Regulation Nos. 7(a) and 16.

The Board has agreed to accept, and shall impose upon Licensee, the following sanction:

- **Seven (7) day suspension of its First & Third Class Liquor Licenses to be served on consecutive days beginning July 19, 2014 and ending on July 25, 2014. Licenses would be reinstated at the start of business on July 26, 2014. All members involved in service of alcoholic beverages would be required to attend in-person DLC training.**

Licensee acknowledges and agrees that, at all times and in all communications and proceedings related to this matter and to this Agreement, it has had the right to be and has been represented and advised by legal counsel. Licensee has carefully reviewed and considered this Agreement with the assistance of its counsel. Licensee agrees and understands that, by executing this Agreement, it is waiving any right to a formal hearing related to the Notice of Hearing (thereby waiving any right to be presented with the evidence against it, to cross-examine adverse witnesses, and to offer evidence of his own to contest the DLC's allegation(s)) and waiving any right to challenge the jurisdiction and continuing jurisdiction of the Board in this matter. *See 7 V.S.A. § 236; 3 V.S.A. §§ 809, 814.*
