SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

AGONY, LLC d/b/a THE LOCAL ("Licensee") was served a Notice of Hearing directing it to appear before the Liquor Control Board ("Board") on November 12, 2014 at Montpelier, Vermont for a contested case hearing to consider the suspension or revocation of its First and Third Class Liquor Licenses and has reached an agreement with the Department of Liquor Control ("DLC") to settle the violation(s) alleged against it in the Notice of Hearing, specifically: General Regulations No. 17 and 36(a).


The Board has agreed to accept, and shall impose upon Licensee, the following sanction:

- Seven (7) day suspension of Licensee's First & Third Class Liquor Licenses to be served on consecutive days beginning at the close on November 29, 2014 to and including the opening of business on December 7, 2014. *of course 11/29 CG SO*
- All patrons shall be screened with metal detecting equipment to screen for weapons prior to being granted entry into the premises.
- Licensee will preserve all surveillance videos it takes in and outside its premises for thirty (30) days from the date of recording and is subject to General Regulation 7. Licensee will implement procedures to accomplish this within 10 business days from the approval of this agreement
- Licensee will display notice that video surveillance is in use.

Licensee acknowledges and agrees that, at all times and in all communications and proceedings related to this matter and to this Agreement, it has had the right to be and has been represented and advised by legal counsel. Licensee has carefully reviewed and considered this Agreement with the assistance of its counsel. Licensee agrees and understands that, by executing this Agreement, it is waiving any right to a formal hearing related to the Notice of Hearing (thereby waiving any right to be presented with the evidence against it, to cross-examine adverse witnesses, and to offer evidence of his own to contest the DLC's allegation(s)) and waiving any right to challenge the jurisdiction and continuing jurisdiction of the Board in this matter. See 7 V.S.A. § 236; 3 V.S.A. §§ 809, 814.


