ORDER

On May 20, 2013, the Liquor Control Board ("Board") revoked Wattle Creek Winery's ("Licensee") Direct Shipper's License for failing to file timely, required reports pursuant to 7 V.S.A. §66(e)(4)(A)-(C).

Licensee did not appear at the May 8, 2013 hearing (in person or via telephone), which was held to determine the merits of their alleged violation. Licensee did not contest the alleged violation. The Board's May 20, 2013 decision was never appealed.


On November 12, 2014, the Department of Liquor Control advised the Board that the required reports had, in fact, been timely filed and that it was error to have alleged any violations against the Licensee. Licensee, therefore, did not violate 7 V.S.A. §66(e)(4)(A)-(C).

Accordingly, the Board hereby **RESCINDS** its order of May 20, 2013. Licensee may renew their Direct Shipper's License should it choose to do so.
