SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

JRS Corp. d/b/a Akes Place ("Licensee") was notified to appear for an August 10, 2016 contested case hearing wherein the Liquor Control Board ("Board") would consider the suspension or revocation of Licensee's First and Third Class Liquor Licenses for alleged violations of General Regulation Nos. 17, 33 and 45 and has reached an agreement with the Department of Liquor Control ("DLC"). The Board has agreed to accept the following sanction for the violations as charged:

- **LICENSEE'S FIRST AND THIRD CLASS LIQUOR LICENSES SHALL BE SUSPENDED FOR TWO (2) BUSINESS DAYS AND SAID SUSPENSION SHALL BE SERVED FROM THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON SATURDAY, AUGUST 20, 2016 (SPECIFICALLY 2 A.M., SUNDAY, AUGUST 21, 2016) TO THE OPENING OF BUSINESS ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 23, 2016.**

Licensee acknowledges and agrees that, at all times and in all communications and proceedings related to this matter and to this Agreement, it has had the right to be and has been represented and advised by legal counsel. Licensee has carefully reviewed and considered this Agreement with the assistance of its counsel. Licensee agrees and understands that, by executing this Agreement, it is waiving any right to a hearing related to the matter before the Board on August 10, 2016 (thereby waiving any right to be presented with the evidence against it, to cross-examine adverse witnesses, and to offer evidence of its own to contest the DLC's allegation(s)) and waiving any right to challenge the jurisdiction and continuing jurisdiction of the Board in this matter. See 7 V.S.A. § 236; 3 V.S.A. §§ 809, 814.
