

Food Truck Liquor License Requirements

Food trucks must meet specific licensing requirements to serve alcohol in Vermont.



1ST/3RD CLASS LICENSE

Must obtain a 1st and/or 3rd Class License and meet all license requirements.



DOH LICENSE

Must hold and maintain a license issued by the Vermont Department of Health.



MULTIPLE LOCATIONS

Must apply for licenses for each location if serving alcohol in more than one location.



CLEAN WATER SUPPLY

Must have connection to a clean water supply. License is void when disconnected from water supply.



FOOD MUST BE AVAILABLE

Must have food available. No beverage only trucks allowed.



POWER SOURCE

Must have a connection to power. License is void when disconnected from power supply.



BATHROOMS

Must have bathroom facilities available at all times for customers.



TOWN APPROVAL REQUIRED

Must receive approval from the town(s) where the food truck will be operating for all licenses and permits.



OUTSIDE CONSUMPTION PERMIT

Must hold an Outside Consumption Permit and follow all permit requirements including having a clearly defined consumption area.
