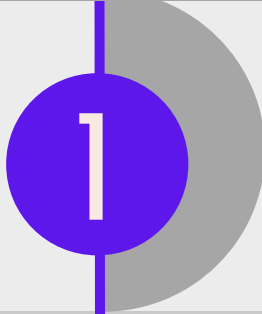
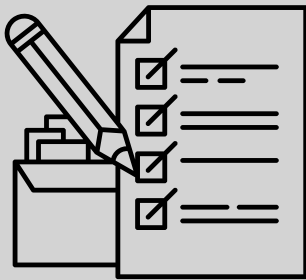


# WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT SAMPLING EVENT PERMITS



## WHAT IS IT

This is a permit for an event that is open to the public, whose primary purpose is to serve malt, vinous, ready-to-drink spirits beverages, hard cider, spirits or fortified wines. Attendees must pay an entry fee of no less than \$5



## APPLICATIONS

This \$125 permit must be approved by the town and submitted for approval by DLL at least 15 days prior to the event date. A person shall be granted not more than 4 Sampling Event Permits per year and each permit shall be valid for no more than 4 consecutive days.

## MALT & HARD CIDER

For malt beverages and hard cider, attendees can be served product in containers not more than 12 ounces with not more than 60 ounces served per patron per event



## MIXED EVENT AMOUNTS

In an event where combinations of beverages are mutually sampled, attendees shall not be served more than a combined total of 6 US Standard drinks containing 3.6 fluid ounces or 84 grams of pure ethyl alcohol

## RULES

Alcohol for the event must be purchased from a licensed manufacturer or packager or one that holds a federal Basic Permit or Brewers Notice.

All servers must have valid 1st class server certifications and all other DLL Regulations concerning serving alcohol must be followed
