Pay by check or money order in U.S. funds; make checks payable to VT DEPT. OF LIQUOR CONTROL. This plea will be entered into Licensee's enforcement history.

IF LICENSEE PLEADS <u>DENIED</u>: Mark the plea, and sign and complete above. Deliver the plea to the Department of Liquor Control within ten (10) days. Licensee will be scheduled to appear before the Liquor Control Board. There is more detailed information about appearing before the Board on the back of the other copy of the complaint, which should be kept for reference.

IF LICENSEE FAILS TO DELIVER A PLEA WITHIN TEN (10) DAYS OF COMPLAINT: The Department of Liquor Control will impose the designated fine and Licensee will be liable for payment. If Licensee fails to pay the designated fine within ten (10) days thereafter, Licensee will be ordered to a hearing before the Liquor Control Board to consider liquor license suspension or revocation.


Narrative:

On the above date and time I observed several large bottles of spirits in the supply room of Baja Burrito located on Killington Road. In speaking with the bartender on duty (acting manager), he advised they were refilling small bottles on the bar with the large bottles in the inventory. I advised him of the regulation violation and issued an administrative ticket #00060 for regulation #43 in the amount of \$500. He called the owner to advise of the violation and will use the large bottle on the bar in the future.

I found the beer cooler and spirit room located in the basement open and accessible to anyone in the hotel. This area was not monitored and I was able to walk through with out detection or interaction with any employee. He was going to take corrective action to lock the area.

NOTICE OF HEARING

RE: Hearing to consider the suspension or revocation of the First and Third Class Licenses granted to Baja Burrito Company, Ltd., Killington Road, Killington, Vermont said licenses being granted to sell alcoholic liquor for on-premise consumption.

Please take notice that pursuant to the authority vested in the Vermont Liquor Control Board by Title 7, Section 236, Vermont Statutes Annotated, a hearing will be held before the Liquor Control Board at the Department of Liquor Control, 13 Green Mountain Drive, Montpelier, Vermont on Wednesday, March 21, 2012 at 9:30 a.m.

The hearing will be held as a formal hearing and will be held to consider the suspension or revocation of the first and third class licenses granted to **Baja Burrito Company**, **Ltd.**, **Killington**, **Vermont**, said licenses being granted to sell alcoholic liquor for on-premise consumption, for alleged violation of General Regulation No. 43 of the regulations duly adopted by the Liquor Control Board, which is set forth and specified below.

General Regulation No. 43: Except as otherwise authorized by law or Liquor Control Board regulation, licensees shall not reuse, refill or tamper with any bottle of alcoholic beverages nor shall such licensee adulterate, dilute, fortify, or cause any substitution of any nature to be made in or to the contents of any bottle of alcoholic beverages.

It is alleged that you have knowingly been refilling bottles of spirituous liquors in violation of General regulation No. 43

The Liquor Control Board shall determine whether or not such alleged violations did occur as specified herein.

Pursuant to Title 3, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Section 809(d), the said Baja Burrito Company, Ltd. shall have an opportunity by themselves or through their attorney to appear at said hearing to present evidence and argument on all issues involved in this case and bring before the Liquor Control Board all pertinent facts that the said licensee believes will have a bearing on the issues involved in this case.

The liquor control investigator's report is enclosed.

All correspondence and documents pertaining to this matter should be sent to the Vermont Department of Liquor Control, 13 Green Mountain Drive, Montpelier, Vermont, 05602, to my attention.
