RE: Hearing to consider the suspension or revocation of the First and Third Class Licenses granted to The Dover Bar and Grill Corporation d/b/a Dover Bar and Grill, Main, Route 100, West Dover, Vermont said licenses being granted to sell alcoholic liquor for on-premise consumption.

Please take notice that pursuant to the authority vested in the Vermont Liquor Control Board by Title 7, Section 236, Vermont Statutes Annotated, a hearing will be held before the Liquor Control Board at the Department of Liquor Control, 13 Green Mountain Drive, Montpelier, Vermont on Wednesday, April 11, 2012 at 9:30 a.m.

The hearing will be held as a formal hearing and will be held to consider the suspension or revocation of the first and third class licenses granted to **The Dover Bar and Grill Corporation, Vermont**, said licenses being granted to sell alcoholic liquor for on-premise consumption, for alleged violation of General Regulation No. 16 and Hours of Sale No. 1 of the regulations duly adopted by the Liquor Control Board, which is set forth and specified below.

General Regulation No. 16: No licensee, employee, or anyone involved in the sale or furnishing of alcoholic beverages, and/or the enforcement on the premises of the laws, rules and regulations of this State pertaining to the sale or furnishing of alcoholic beverages, shall consume or display the effects of alcohol or any illegal substance while in the performance of their duties.

Hours of Sale Regulation No. 1: Holders of a first class license or first and third class licenses shall sell or serve any malt or vinous beverages or spirituous liquors on his / her licensed premises between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. the following morning. Consumption on the premises of such beverages and liquors sold and served pursuant to this regulation shall be prohibited after 2:30 a.m. Except as otherwise prohibited by law or regulation, the hours provided in this regulation shall be extended one hour for New Year's Day

It is alleged that on February 17, 2012 your employee, Jason Hathaway, was consuming alcoholic beverages while in the performance of his duties in violation of General Regulation No. 16.

It is alleged that on February 17, 2012 you served alcoholic beverages to a patron after the legal serving hour of 2:00 a.m. in violation of Hours of Sale Regulation No. 1.

The Liquor Control Board shall determine whether or not such alleged violations did occur as specified herein.

Pursuant to Title 3, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Section 809(d), the said **The Dover Bar and Grill Corporation** shall have an opportunity by themselves or through their attorney to appear at said hearing to present evidence and argument on all issues involved in this case and bring before the Liquor Control Board all pertinent facts that the said licensee believes will have a bearing on the issues involved in this case.

The liquor control investigator's report is enclosed.



On February 17, 2012, at approximately 1:30am, I conducted an inspection at the Dover Bar and Grill located on Route 100, in the town of Dover. While conducting my inspection I noted the bartender, later identified as Jason Hathaway (DOB August 5, 1969) consume two shots of what I believe to be Yeager Meister. The bartender walked to the back of the bar thinking he was out of sight of the patrons and consumed the shots. While I was in the bar I was not recognized as an investigator, so I continued to watch the activities at the bar until 2:15am. I also noted that 2:10am the bartender poured and serve a beer to one of the patrons sitting at the bar. I identified myself and spoke to the bartender who admitted to me that he was drinking on-duty and that he knew it was wrong to serve alcohol after hours but served his off-duty Cook one beer. I obtained a sworn written statement which is attached and incorporated by reference from Mr. Hathaway. Mr. Hathaway consented to an Alco sensor and had a BAC of .065. I issued two administrative tickets, one for employee drinking on-duty ticket number 00853 and sale of alcohol after hour's, ticket number 00852. Mr. Hathaway will also be issued a criminal citation to appear in Windham Superior Court to answer to the charge of sale of alcohol after hours a Violation of Title 7 section 62.
