To All Liquor Brokers & Suppliers:

The following criteria have been established for delistings starting January 1, 2024:

For the delistings that will take place quarterly (January 1, April 1, July 1 and October 1), there will be no appeals process.

Suppliers will have thirty (30) days to pick up the product left in the warehouse after it is delisted. There will be a six-month minimum before a product can be offered for re-listing.

New Delisting Criteria: All products (High volume, Medium volume and Low volume code status) need to have a gross income of more than \$3,500.

R1-High Volume--\$7,000+ R2-Medium Volume--\$4,500 to \$6,999 R3-Low Volume--\$3,500 to \$4,499 New items—items are new for twelve months from the listing date Special orders—Under \$3,499 Allocated items—Highly allocated items/raffle/sweepstakes Holiday items/One-time buys Delisted items—High Volume and Medium Volume items need to have a gross income of more than \$4,500. Discontinued items—Not available from Supplier Inactive items--no product available anywhere-not in registers

Please note that items can move up and down, according to the above criteria. If the gross income drops below the minimum threshold for R3-low volume, the item will be delisted.
