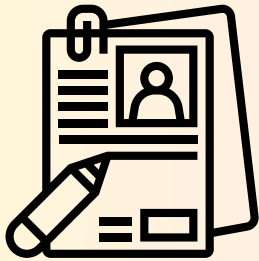


WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT SPECIAL VENUE PERMITS



WHAT IS IT

This permit allows a library, museum, art gallery or retail establishment to serve alcohol at an event lasting up to 6 hours.



SERVING

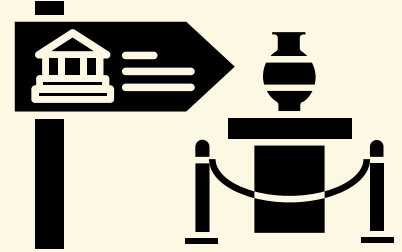
This permit allows the business to hold an event serving malt, vinous, hard cider or ready to drink spirit's beverages sourced from a Vermont store.



RULES

This permit requires a valid Special Venue Permit training certification to pour. All other DLL Regulations concerning serving alcohol must be followed

APPLICATIONS

These businesses can apply for up to 12 permits a calendar year
Each Permit costs \$20.
Businesses can charge for attendance but not for the alcohol served at the event.

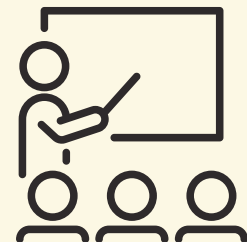

SUNSET JULY 2026

For the purpose of this permit, retail establishments do not include DLL licensed businesses, 802 Spirits locations or cannabis establishments. Upon sunset this reverts from retail establishments to bookstores.
